This SOP how to implement the CSU Reset process.

Procedure

The following information is to support the implementation of the above referenced policy. This document shall not preclude staff from using their professional judgement based on individual circumstances, consistent with the requirements of the policy.

- I. A CSU Reset for a 15-20 minute regulation period can be requested by youth once per shift, after all coping skills and interventions have been exhausted, without becoming a CSU admission.
 - A. Youth requesting a CSU Reset more than once in a shift will transition to the CSU as an admission.

- II. If the CSU is occupied by a CSU Admission or other youth utilizing a CSU Reset, an alternate location will be determined by the On-Duty Supervisor.

- III. If a youth's individualized needs cannot be met by the above detailed CSU Reset process, a separate plan will be developed by the treatment team that outlines additional supportive interventions for the youth.
