Healthcare-associated Infections End-Stage Renal Dialysis Centers (ESRD) Reporting Requirements for 2021

Who is required to report:

Any End-Stage Renal Dialysis Center (ESRD) licensed pursuant to RSA 151:32-35.

What must be reported:

Vascular Access Site Infections (VASI)

- 1. Follow National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) protocols and definitions
- 2. ESRD shall report on the following NHSN access site infections:
 - a. Bloodstream infection (BSI)
 - b. Local access site infection (LASI)
 - c. Access-related bloodstream infection (ARBSI); and
 - d. Vascular access infection (VAI)
- 3. Monitor patients for VASI all 12 calendar months and shall report data into NSHN.
- 4. Monitor and report in NHSN at least within 60 days of the close of each quarter
 - a. Quarter 1 data (Jan 1st to Mar 31st) due on or before May 30th
 - b. Quarter 2 data (Apr 1st to Jun 30th) due on or before Aug 29th
 - c. Quarter 3 data (Jul 1st to Sep 30th) due on or before Nov 29th
 - d. Quarter 4 data (Oct 1st to Dec 31st) due on or before Mar 1st of following calendar year

Positive Blood Culture

- 1. Follow National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) protocols and definitions
- 2. Monitor patients for positive blood cultures all 12 calendar months and shall report data into NSHN.
- 3. Monitor and report in NHSN at least within 60 days of the close of each quarter
 - a. Quarter 1 data (Jan 1st to Mar 31st) due on or before May 30th
 - b. Quarter 2 data (Apr 1st to Jun 30th) due on or before Aug 29th
 - c. Quarter 3 data (Jul 1st to Sep 30th) due on or before Nov 29th
 - d. Quarter 4 data (Oct 1st to Dec 31st) due on or before Mar 1st of following calendar year

Surgical Antimicrobial Prophylaxis Administration

- 1. Follow CDC-endorsed NHSN measure for timing of antibiotics, "End Stage Renal Dialysis (ESRD) Event"
- 2. Intravenous antimicrobial prophylaxis will be reported quarterly via a line list containing the information above using a Microsoft Excel file provided by NH DHHS. The file must be submitted within 60 days of the close of each quarter to the HAI program email at <u>dhhs.haiprogram@dhhs.nh.gov</u>.
 - a. Quarter 1 data (Jan 1st to Mar 31st) due on or before May 30th
 - b. Quarter 2 data (Apr 1st to Jun 30th) due on or before Aug 29th
 - c. Quarter 3 data (Jul 1st to Sep 30th) due on or before Nov 29th
 - d. Quarter 4 data (Oct 1st to Dec 31st) due on or before Mar 1st of following calendar year

Influenza Vaccination Rates

- 1. Healthcare personnel influenza vaccination rates data will be reported yearly by April 30th and will include information on influenza vaccine administered during the previous influenza season.
- 2. This information will be collected via NHSN or NoviSurvey, or a combination of the two.
