Due to a boiler failure the New Hampshire Public Health Laboratories (PHL) has suffered temporary water damage and is closed for business. Cleaning and repairs are in progress. The PHL will reopen as the building is cleared for occupancy.

We will continue to receive specimens from Providers for testing and coordinate specimen referral to other New England Public Health Laboratories who have agreed to assist. Those laboratories performing the testing will be noted on the laboratory report. The PHL is expecting to resume routine testing within one week.

Actual:	Communication or alert refers to a live event	
Exercise:	Designated recipients must respond to the communication or alert	
Test:	Communication or alert is related to a technical, system test and should be disregarded	
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<u>Severity</u> Extreme:	Extraordinary throat to life or property	
Severe:	Extraordinary threat to life or property Significant threat to life or property	
Moderate:	Possible threat to life or property	
Minor:	Minimal threat to life or property	
Unknown:	Unknown threat to life or property	
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<u>Sensitive</u> Sensitive:	Indicates the alert contains sensitive content
