



## **ADDENDUM #1**

### **RFP # 17-DHHS-OHS-DCYF-02**

On November 12, 2015 the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a request for applications for an education and training partnership that provides resource families, residential care providers, certain post-adoptive families and certain Division for Children, Youth and Families (DCYF) staff with education and training opportunities that are specific to working with children and families served by the Division.

The Division is publishing this addendum to

1. Delete and replace the Paragraph 3.2.4 with the following:
  - 3.2.4. The Contractor shall collaborate with DCYF to design and/or update and deliver training programs and educational opportunities based upon the agency priorities, such as the Child and Family Services Review, Practice Model, and adoption of evidence-based practices, and changing federal legislation, i.e. Trauma Informed approaches, Better Together with Birth Parents, Therapeutic Crisis Intervention, Residential Provider Sexual Harassment and Assault Awareness, Reasonable and Prudent Parenting Standards, etc.
