1.	May we make the case for a lower age group and their parents?	No.
2.	Does a vendor choose whether to use subcontractors for providing the services required under this RFP?	Yes; however, the Department reserves the right to approve or deny the use of any subcontractor.
3.	Can the Department identify any online, innovative programming targeting parents of selected/indicated youth?	There are some examples of online parenting programs for youth and/or parents who are court involved, such as Active Parenting and Positive Parenting, that have proven effective.
4.	How will the Department measure the outcomes in Subsections 3.5.2.3. Parental Efficacy and 3.5.2.4. Parental Communication and Monitoring from programs selected; through PWITS or survey or both?	Via a pre-post survey for participants in youth and parent programs.
5.	Can we use this funding to focus solely on the highest need communities; bearing in mind their data must be higher than state average?	All applications will be reviewed to ensure: 1. The vendor has the experience to work with the targeted populations; 2. There is solid justification for geographic region(s) to be served; and 3. The vendor has the capacity to serve the identified region(s).
