



Notice Regarding Addendum #5 Published On

September 30, 2016

Although the vendor Question and Answer period expired on September 13, 2016, the Department is issuing this notice to answer any questions vendors may have about the most recent Addendum posted on September 30, 2016.

One of the requirements of Chapter 330:13 of the Laws of 2016 (SB 533), is that, in order to be eligible to receive grant funding for the creation, initiation, expansion, and/or operational costs for peer recovery support services from the Department, existing and proposed peer recovery support services organizations must be registered with the association of recovery community organizations under the Faces and Voices of Recovery.

Addendum #5 makes clear that selected vendor(s) must be registered with the association of recovery community organizations under the Faces and Voices of Recovery prior to the award of a contract by Governor and Council. The Department is willing to accept proposals from vendors who are not yet registered but can demonstrate that they are capable of being in compliance with the legal requirement of registration with the association of recovery community organizations under the Faces and Voices of Recovery prior to the award of a contract by Governor and Council.
