

CONDITIONS FOR LENDING

1. You **must** be a New Hampshire resident or working in an agency located in New Hampshire to borrow from this collection.
2. You must agree to return the materials in good condition in a timely manner by either sending (*please wrap in bubble wrap*) the materials back to the **NH Alcohol, Tobacco & Other Drug Abuse Clearinghouse** by insured mail or returning materials directly to the office at **105 Pleasant Street, Concord, NH 03301-3852**.
3. You must give a contacting address and phone number where we may reach you about the material you have borrowed.
4. You may borrow **5** items from our library at any one time. If you want to borrow more it must be reviewed by Lending Library staff.
5. You must be a borrower in good standing. We reserve the right to deny lending privileges at any time.

PROCEDURE FOR LENDING

1. Look through the catalogue and choose the items that you would like to borrow.
2. Fill out the "Lending Library Transaction Form" with your address, phone number, and all other contacting information. Fill out the **ID number AND title** of each resource that you would like to borrow.
3. Please fax, mail, or bring your form into the office.
4. If you are mailing or faxing your form, the resources will be sent out of this office to you within 7 business days from when we receive your form. If there is a rush, please let us know, and we will try to respond promptly.
5. You have **2 weeks** with which to use your loaned materials (*if need more time please let us know*). They may be used in classes, for groups, and in any educational setting. The videos may not be broadcast over the television without permission of the production agency.
6. You **must** return your materials at the end of 2 weeks (*or agreed upon date*) to the office or **call and extend your lending time**. If shipping, please wrap carefully in bubble wrap and mail or send insured. Please fill out the survey on the back of your lending form when returning your materials. This helps us keep up-to-date with the quality of the materials we offer.
7. Resources that are not returned in the prescribed manner are the responsibility of the borrowing organization and the responsible person listed on the transaction form. Replacement cost for the lost resources will be charged to the person and/or organization borrowing the materials.
