NEUROMOTOR CLINIC SERVICES

WHAT IS NEUROMOTOR CLINIC ?

Special Medical Services Neuromotor Teams provide assessment, treatment, recommendations and ongoing care coordination for children with physical disabilities associated with orthopedic, neurological, muscular and/or motor coordination delays.

WHO ARE THE CHILDREN WE SERVE?

- Children birth to age 21 years of age regardless of family income
 - Who have a Neuromotor condition. These are characterized by an inability to fully control motor functions. These may include spasticity, muscle tone imbalance, involuntary movement or problems with gait or mobility. Examples include cerebral palsy, congenital abnormalities and other physical and neurological impairments
 - Who would benefit from health care coordination
 - Who are residents of New Hampshire

WHO ARE THE NEUROMOTOR CLINICAL TEAM MEMBERS ?

- Pediatric Orthopedist
- Developmental Pediatrician
- Pediatric Physical Therapist
- Nurse Care Coordinator
- Clinic Assistant

WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE IN THE NEUROMOTOR CLINIC PROGRAM?

- Coordination and follow-up of team recommendations with health care providers and specialists
- Assessment, recommendations and consultations about specialty equipment needs & resources
- Referral to nutrition, feeding and swallowing specialists
- Consultation with schools and other programs to assist in planning educational services to meet each child's special needs
- Connection to counseling, supports and resource services
- Financial assistance for health related expenses to income eligible families

HOW DO I GET A REFERRAL TO THE PROGRAM ?
