



SPECIAL MEDICAL SERVICES

Special Medical Services (SMS), the New Hampshire Title V Program for Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN), offers health programs and services for children ages birth to 21 years, who have, or are at risk for a chronic medical condition, disability or special health care need.

SERVICES AVAILABLE THROUGH SMS

- ◆ **Care Coordination Program**
 - ◇ Care Coordination services are provided to any family with a child who has special health care needs regardless of family income or where families go to receive medical services.
 - ◇ Community based care coordinators help families access needed health care and related services, including assistance finding medical, social, psychological, educational and financial assistance and resources.
- ◆ **Nutrition, Feeding & Swallowing Program**
 - ◇ Provides a statewide network of pediatric dietitians and feeding specialists offering consultation in the home/community.
- ◆ **Neuromotor Clinic Program**
 - ◇ Provides a specialized team approach and coordinated care for children with physical disabilities associated with significant orthopedic, neurologic, muscular and motor coordination delays.
- ◆ **Child Development Clinic Program**
 - ◇ Provides comprehensive diagnostic evaluations for children whose parents have concerns about their child's development or behavior, including Autism Spectrum disorders.
- ◆ **Psychology and Psychiatry consultations may be arranged by referral.**
