10.4,5,6 Report Updates to data collection protocol and instances of service & quality data and outcome measures collection

There have been no changes to the data collection protocol as of January 1, 2013. The following chart describes current data collection.

- Service data has been collected for all of Federal Fiscal Year 2012 using the CMS 64 and the DHHS Provider Payment Report. The BIP Category of Service Report will be compiled on a quarterly basis, beginning with the fourth quarter of calendar year 2012.
- Quality data will be collected subsequent to the implementation of NH Medicaid Care Management Phase II.
- The most recent surveys identified for outcome measures have also been collected.

NH BIP is working to use the data to develop summary charts of Long Term Care services cost and utilization. The charts will be used to establish a baseline and track trends over time showing the effectiveness of the BIP initiatives.
