# Alignment of School Administrative Units (SAU) and Public Health Regions

- Of the 86 SAUs in New Hampshire for the 2013-14 school year:
- 84% of all SAUs are in a single Public Health Region (n = 72)
- 15% of all SAUs are in two Public Health Regions (n = 13)
- 1% of all SAUs are in three Public Health Regions (n = 1)

# Alignment of Hospital Services Areas and Public Health Regions

Of the 22 Hospital Service Areas in New  
Hampshire:

- 14 Hospital Service Areas are in a single Public Health Region
- 8 Hospital Service Areas are in 2 Public Health Regions

# Alignment of Counties and Public Health Regions

- Of the 10 Counties in New Hampshire:
- 5 counties are in a single Public Health Region (Belknap, Carroll, Cheshire, Coos, and Strafford)
- 1 county is in 2 different Public Health Regions (Greater Sullivan)
- 2 counties are in 3 different Public Health Regions (Grafton, Hillsborough)
- 2 counties are in 4 different Public Health Regions (Merrimack, Rockingham)
