

# The Northern New England Poison Center is Ready to Serve You at 1-800-222-1222



The Northern New England Poison Center has a toll free number for you to call with questions about poisonings 24 hours a day.

Call 1-800-222-1222 any time of the day, any day of the year. This number will connect you to the local Poison Center from anywhere in the country.

**If the person you are concerned about has stopped breathing, is choking or has collapsed then call 911 immediately. If 911 feels that your question is better answered by the Poison Center they will transfer your call.**

Call the Poison Center with any of these kinds of questions:

**“My baby just ate some diaper rash ointment, will she be OK?”**

**“Mom sometimes gets confused. She took all of her daily medications at once. Is this a problem?”**

**“My daughter has eaten some wild berries. Her mouth and tongue are red. Is this a poisonous plant?”**

**“I was cutting hot peppers for dinner and then rubbed my eye by mistake. It won’t stop burning!”**

**“My dog ate an ant trap. Does he need to be taken to the veterinarian?”**

You can get a lot of information over the phone and someone is always there! If you need medical care, you will be referred to your health care provider or to the emergency department if immediate attention is needed.
