

Step 2 Update

Information Sessions on Transition of Additional Groups into Medicaid Care Management for Medical Services - Phase 1 of Step 2

The NH Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has scheduled public information sessions to inform Medicaid recipients and providers about the transition into Medicaid Care Management for additional Medicaid-eligible groups. Medicaid recipients who were able to opt out of Medicaid Care Management, known as voluntaries, will be required to enroll in a health plan for their medical services. The voluntary population will be mandated to join a health plan or they will be auto-assigned to one of the two health plans. Timing of enrollment is contingent on Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS) approval.

DHHS, in conjunction with New Hampshire Healthy Families and the Well Sense Health Plan, held the first session on June 24th in Concord. Three sessions will be held in July: in Nashua on July 14th, Littleton on July 16th, and Keene on July 22nd. An additional session will be held on August 6th in Rochester. All sessions will offer in-person or webinar attendance. The sessions are two hours long, followed by an opportunity to ask individual questions at the health plan's meeting rooms.
