RE: He-C 6339 “Certification Payment Standards for Community Based In-Home Service Providers”

1. Status: November 28, 2016 He-C 6339 filed with MCAC for December 12, 2016 meeting. The Department requests this rule be placed on the MCAC agenda for December 12, 2016.

3. Rule Summary:

- **Reason for rulemaking (e.g., expiration, statutory change, policy change).**
 - He-C 6339 is in interim status and is scheduled to expire March 18, 2017. The rulemaking is being entered to prevent expiration.
- **General overview of the rule.**
 - He-C 6339 identifies the qualifications, performance requirements and standards for payment through Medicaid or financial reimbursement from the department of health and human services (DHHS) for providers who seek to be, or are certified for payment as a provider of community based in-home services that support children and families by providing services to help address individual and family behaviors that can cause abuse, neglect and delinquent events. The services described in He-C 6339 include child health support, home based therapeutic, therapeutic day treatment, adolescent community therapeutic services and individual services options in-home. The rule is being updated to include the certification requirements for each type of provider certified by payment by DHHS, and to incorporate by reference the forms for certification.
