Assisted Living communities provide services to needy individuals that are possible only in a communal setting – 24 hours per day with multiple services: health, activities, dining, transportation, maintenance, housekeeping, etc. The residents make these communities their “home” with new family members becoming fellow residents and staff.

My concern is that the transition plan for the CFI program take into account the positive benefits that AL has for the residents and that the residents are not pulled out of their comfortable homes and thrust out into the community where “services received” are at a much lower level.
