- NH STATE STATUTES – CHAPTER 326H: LICENSED DIETITIANS  
SECTION 326-H:14 - Paragraph II

All licenses issued by the board shall be valid for 2 years from the date of issuance and shall be renewed biennially or reissued pursuant to rules adopted and upon payment of a \$110 license renewal fee. The board shall cause notification of impending licenses expiration to be sent to each licensed person at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the license. **Licenses shall continue to be valid until final action is exercised by the board on an application for renewal, provided that the application is filed before the expiration date of the license.**
