ADDENDUM

Introduction

Upon completing the final year of the 2017-2020 Suicide Prevention Plan, the Suicide Prevention Council (SPC) leadership embarked on a 2021-2024 strategic planning process that would enable members to think aspirationally about the Council's potential impact. Throughout the planning phase, SPC Leadership wished to explore ways to create efficiencies and increase effectiveness.

SPC engaged Pear Associates to support the planning process. Working collaboratively with SPC leaders and members, Pear Associates facilitated a six-month process that included the following steps:



Information Gathering and Level Setting

Pear Associates held a Kickoff Meeting with the Chair and Vice-Chairs to understand SPC and its current challenges. The discussion focused on what worked well with the last planning process and SPC leadership's desire for a new approach. Leaders wanted to align SPC Subcommittee work with Council goals while recognizing the Subcommittees' interconnectivity and interdependence. The Kickoff Meeting also addressed shifts in the suicide prevention landscape, including the potential impact of COVID-19.

The Pear Associates team reviewed shared and publicly-available materials, including the New Hampshire Suicide Prevention Plan 2017-2020, New Hampshire Suicide Prevention Annual Report, and NH 10-year Mental Health Plan, the SPC charter, as well as enabling legislation. The Pear Associates team also reviewed state and national resources on suicide prevention best practices, including those developed by the Suicide Prevention Resource Center, Zero Suicide, and American Foundation for Suicide Prevention.

Pear Associates facilitated two level-setting meetings with the SPC Leadership Group and the SPC Full Council to share the purpose of the planning process, the timeline, and the data collection process. SPC announced the convening of an Ad-Hoc Strategic Planning Committee and invited participation from across the Council.

Assessing Progress Towards 2017-2020 Plan

To assess progress towards the goals and objectives outlined in the 2017-2020 Plan, Pear Associates developed and distributed an electronic survey to all members using the Survey Monkey® tool. The survey asked for input on all 2017-2020 Council and Subcommittee goals and objectives to determine what has been achieved. For those goals and objectives not reached, the survey asked for feedback on the contributing factors. The survey was distributed to

the entire membership by SPC leaders, with follow-up prompts to encourage completion before the Leadership Group meeting in November 2020. The initial poll only resulted in 17 responses, which the SPC Leadership Group felt was inconclusive. They requested that Pear Associates seek additional input from the Full Committee through a different strategy.

Pear Associates developed a streamlined version of the progress survey, which was implemented “on-the-spot” during the SPC Full Membership meeting in December 2020. This survey asked for input on all 2017-2020 Council goals and objectives to determine what has been achieved. The survey also asked participants to identify challenges and facilitators (things that helped) to meeting goals and objectives. The survey conducted during the Full meeting received 27 responses.

Included in this document is a copy of the surveys and the analysis provided by Survey Monkey.

Development of Strategic Directions

Pear Associates facilitated two planning sessions among the SPC Strategic Planning Subcommittee. These two-hour virtual sessions used a combination of presentation, discussion, and breakout groups.

During the initial meeting, Pear Associates reviewed state and national data on suicide rates and the impact of COVID-19 on mental health and substance use disorders with the group. Pear Associates presented the results of the “on-the-spot” survey held during the Full Membership meeting. The structure of the SPC was also reviewed and affirmed.

Additional topics covered at the initial meeting included exploring the Suicide Prevention Resource Center (SPRC) and state infrastructure recommendations. The SPC Strategic Planning Subcommittee broke into three facilitated discussion groups to conduct a self-assessment to determine how the SPC aligns with the SPRC 6 Essential Elements.

Following the meeting and based on inconsistent outcomes from the three smaller groups, Pear Associates asked each Strategic Planning Subcommittee member to complete the Essential Elements Assessment survey. Strategic Planning Subcommittee members explored each element to determine SPC’s achievement level on particular focus areas through the survey tool. Also, through the survey, Strategic Planning Subcommittee members prioritized the elements.

At the second meeting, Pear Associates reviewed the Essential Elements Assessment survey results. The Strategic Planning Subcommittee then broke into three facilitated discussion groups to explore the “Build” element, which unanimously was identified as the priority element. The second meeting also included a report from Pear Associates on the results of the three facilitated discussion groups. Pear Associates reviewed the SPC charter to ensure Strategic Planning Subcommittee members were familiar with the legislative mandate for the Council. Finally, Pear Associates presented the status and role of a soon-to-be hired Suicide Prevention Coordinator and how it would enhance the SPC’s work.

Information Synthesis and Plan Development

Pear Associates synthesized the data compiled and collected during the planning process and created a draft plan. The initial draft was shared with the Chair and Vice-Chairs for initial review and feedback. Based on SPC leadership input, Pear Associates reviewed the draft plan and shared a final plan.
