Is this grant intended to provide funding for a new adult day program to be created or for an existing program to be able to offer services to patients who do not currently qualify through their Medicaid coverage?	<p>Per Section 1. Request for Services, the Department is seeking applications from licensed organizations to provide Adult Day Program Services pursuant to the Older American Act, Title III Services and Title XX Social Services Block Grant Services (to enter into a contract for services).</p> <p>Per Section 1.1. Eligibility Criteria, specifically Sub-section 1.1.5. specifies services are intended for individuals who are <u>not</u> already receiving the same or similar services through one of the Department's Medicaid Waiver Programs and individuals who are receiving the same or similar services through the Veterans' Administration or through the Medicare Program.</p>

3.	If this grant is an extension of an existing grant, what agency currently receives the grant?	This funding is not an extension of an existing grant.
4.	How could this grant be used by an existing adult day program that serves patients who are in the NH Medicaid program?	This funding is intended to support program participants who are not eligible for Medicaid, Medicare or Veterans' Administration payment for Adult Day Services. An existing program can utilize this funding as an additional funding stream to support participants who are not covered for Adult Day Services through Medicaid, Medicare or the Veterans' Administration.
