



## **ADDENDUM #4**

On March 6, 2018, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a request for proposals, requesting proposals from qualified vendors to enter into a lease agreement to occupy space that is currently unoccupied at the Sununu Youth Services Center located at 1056 River Road, in Manchester, NH in order to operationalize a 36-bed residential substance use disorder treatment center for adolescents ages twelve (12) to eighteen (18) years.

The Department is publishing this addendum to specify information:

**1. Delete and replace Section 3 Statement of Work, Subsection 3.2 Scope of Services, Paragraph 3.2.2 Treatment and Engagement Approaches, Subparagraph 3.2.2.2 with the following:**

- 3.2.2.2 The selected vendor must provide a full array of Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Recovery Support Services, subject to the oversight and compliance with NH Administrative Rule He-W 513, Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment and Recovery Support Services, to all eligible clients in order to support the Department's effort to transform to a Resiliency and Recovery Oriented Systems of Care (RROSC). (See Section 1.2 for more information.) The selected vendor must provide substance use disorder treatment services that support the Resiliency and Recovery Oriented Systems of Care (RROSC) by operationalizing the Continuum of Care Model (<http://www.dhhs.nh.gov/dcbcs/bdas/continuum-of-care.htm>). The selected vendor is subject to associated rules and requirements of the billing entity when providing services charged to commercial health insurance, Medicaid and/or third party payers.
