Program Evaluation and Data Services for the Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Services System

On May 20, 2020, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, soliciting proposals for the provision of program evaluation and data collection, analysis, and reporting for the Alcohol and Other Drug Continuum of Care (AOD CoC) services system in New Hampshire.

 - 3.1.2.3 The selected Vendor must identify agile software, systems and/or tools that will be utilized to deliver work that is flexible to meet constant changing needs of the projects and systems. The selected Vendor must utilize an iterative process that incorporates continuous quality improvement based on examination of data and stakeholder and/or key informant feedback to improve evaluation methodologies based on advancements in the field.
- 2. Amend Section 3, Statement of Work, Section 3.4, Compliance, Paragraph 3.4.3, Subparagraph 3.4.3.4., to read:**
 - 3.4.3.4 RESERVED
- 3. Amend Section 7, Proposal Outline and Requirements, Subsection, 7.2., Outline and Detail, Paragraph 7.2.11, Required Attachments, Subparagraph 7.2.11.1, Part 7.2.11.1.1 to read:**
 - 7.2.11.1.1 RESERVED.
- 4. Delete Section 8, Mandatory Business Specifications, Subsection 8.1, Contract Terms, Conditions and Liquidated Damages, Forms, Paragraph 8.1.2, Liquidated Damages.**
