 - Fee for Service
 - MAT, Transportation, and Childcare
- Timely, clean billing is critical!!!

Service Fee Table

- Clinical Evaluation: \$275 per evaluation
- Individual Outpatient: \$22 per 15 min unit
- Group Outpatient: \$6.60 per 15 min unit
- Intensive Outpatient: \$104 per day
- Partial Hospitalization \$223 per day
- Transitional Living, Room & Board: \$75 per day
- Low-Intensity Residential: \$119 per day
- High-Intensity Residential Adult: \$154.00 per day
- High-Intensity Residential - Pregnant and Parenting Women, Room and Board: \$75 per day.
- High-Intensity Residential - Pregnant and Parenting Women, Clinical services: \$180 per Day
- Integrated Medication Assisted Treatment: Rates Vary
- Ambulatory Withdrawal Management without Extended On-Site Monitoring: \$104 Per day
- Medically Monitored Inpatient Withdrawal Management: \$215 per day
- Individual Intensive Case Management: \$16.50 per 15 min unit
- Group Intensive Case Management: \$5.50 per 15 min unit
- Child Care for pregnant and parenting women: Rates vary
- Transportation for pregnant and parenting women: Rates vary
