This policy establishes the SYSC's response to special medical needs.

Required Practices

Any deviations to the following information must be documented with Supervisory Approval.

- I. Youth who are identified as having special medical needs shall:
A. Be followed closely by medical and nursing staff;
B. Have a specific written treatment plan;
C. Receive instruction from the medical and nursing staff regarding their health needs (as necessary); and
D. Have provisions in place to ensure that they are able to continue with their educational programming, regardless of medical condition.
II. Youth with special medical needs shall not be isolated from the general population, including within the SYSC School.
III. Medical conditions that require special monitoring must be noted on the youth's Nursing Assessment (Form 2279), and on the Medication Kardex (Form 2255).
IV. Nursing staff shall coordinate with the youth's parents/guardians around any necessary adaptive equipment.
