Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish the procedure for resident's daily living activities.

Policy

- I. Resident Responsibilities for Personal and Unit Space and Possessions:
 - A. Every day each resident shall:
 1. Make his/her bed.
 2. Sweep the floor of his/her room.
 - B. Once a week each resident shall:
 1. Damp mop the floor of his/her room.
 2. Dust the furniture and the windowsill.
 3. Wipe the window.
 - C. Every day unit residents shall, as directed by staff, pick up the dayroom, ensuring that all items are returned to their proper storage locations.
 - D. Every day unit residents shall, as directed by staff, disinfect the sink and toilets and sanitize the showers in the unit bathrooms.
 - E. Residents shall not be paid for the performance of these responsibilities.
- II. Other Residential Unit/Building Responsibilities:
 - A. Residents and staff have responsibilities for the care of common spaces within the building. Such responsibilities may be accomplished through paid resident jobs.
- III. Resident Participation in Unit/Building Activities

- A. Residential and Clinical staff shall develop and plan activities for residential units and buildings that promote positive resident interaction and team building.
- B. As directed to do so by staff, residents shall actively and respectfully participate in such activities as unit/building meetings and discussions, and unit team-building activities.

IV. Personal Appearance

- A. Residents shall maintain a clean and neat appearance that is consistent with the residential dress code.
