

Do you know a young adult who aged out of DCYF foster care placement?



Do you know that as of January 1, 2014, under the Affordable Care Act, he or she may be eligible for health insurance through NH Medicaid.

To be eligible s/he must

- Be between the ages of 18 and 25 and exited out of NH DCYF foster care placement* on or after his or her 18th birthday *(includes foster, relative, shelter and residential care but not secure detention);
- &
- Have qualified for NH Medicaid at the time s/he exited DCYF placement.
