

New Hampshire Family Planning Medical Assistance Program

Covered and Non-Covered Services

The New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services Family Planning Medical Assistance Program is here to improve your ability to access family planning services. For eligible women and men, it is your source for free and confidential family planning services and supplies. The purpose of this Program is to improve the wellbeing of children and families by reducing unintended pregnancies.

Covered Services Are Those For Which The Primary Purpose is Family Planning And Include:

- Visits to receive family planning services including an initial, annual or follow-up visit
- Birth Control (such as the Pill, the patch, IUD, and/or condoms)
- Pregnancy testing
- Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) testing and treatment
- HIV testing as part of the initial visit
- Tubal ligation*
- Vasectomy*
- Vaccinations to prevent cervical cancer
- Patient education and counseling



**informed consent for sterilization required; age and timing requirements must be met*



Non-Covered Services Include:

- Hysterectomies
- Abortions
- Any treatment for the purpose of promoting fertility
- Certain diagnostic procedures such as colposcopy, biopsy, and cryotherapy
- Emergency department visits and other primary care services
