


STD/HIV Partner Services

Partner Services are free to persons who test positive for HIV, Syphilis, Chlamydia and/or Gonorrhea and their sex and/or needle-sharing partners. Services are strictly confidential, voluntary, and absolutely free. Your name is never revealed.

What your partner(s) should know...



A positive test for HIV, Syphilis, Chlamydia and/or Gonorrhea means that you are infected with a communicable disease. Your sex and/or needle-sharing partners should be notified of the need for testing and/or treatment.



Your partner(s) may be infected and not know it...

If they know they may have been exposed, and receive current information about HIV, Syphilis, Chlamydia and/or Gonorrhea, your partner(s) can decide if they want to get tested.

How Partner Services can Help



A counselor can notify your partner(s) for you, provide support and offer referral services without ever revealing your name.

A counselor can help you inform your sex and/or needle-sharing partner(s) of possible exposure.



Counselors can answer questions, offer counseling, HIV/STD testing, and referrals for treatment.

They can assist you in identifying and addressing other medical and non-medical needs.



Your partner(s) receive early medical care for the disease, and learn how to protect others from becoming infected.
