Hepatitis A is a highly-contagious liver infection caused by the Hepatitis A virus.

## What are the symptoms?



Yellow skin or eyes



Abdominal pain



Nausea



Fatigue



Dark urine and/or gray stools



Vomiting



Loss of appetite



Joint pain



Fever

Gay and bisexual men · People with substance use disorder  
People experiencing homelessness · People recently incarcerated

## What can you do?

Get vaccinated · Wash hands frequently  
Avoid sex with infected persons · Don't share personal items
