Individuals indicated for 6-month testing refers to patients having a procedure in the cardiac catheterization lab or the recovery area, patients undergoing procedures in the operating room, or patients admitted to the intensive care unit at Exeter Hospital in Exeter, New Hampshire from December 1, 2011 to May 25, 2012 based on data provided by Exeter Hospital.
2. Includes patients who have died since their procedure date and persons who have refused testing to date.
3. Does not include 82 patients tested at the PHL who are not indicated for testing: 80 are negative, 2 are positive for HCV unrelated to the outbreak.
