Weekly Pease Perfluorochemical (PFC) Testing Program Update

Community Engagement:

- DHHS and the community advisory board (CAB) hosted a community meeting to present a preliminary summary of and discuss test results for children 11 years of age and younger on Wednesday September 9th.

Testing & Reporting:

- DHHS has resumed PFC testing for individuals who missed the testing in April-May and who may have consumed contaminated drinking water on the Pease Tradeport. This will be the final round of testing in order for DHHS to analyze the results and present the community with a final summary report of the entire PFC testing program.
 - Individuals who would like to know their blood PFC levels can call the DHHS Public Inquiry Line at 603-271-9461, Monday–Friday, 8:00 am–4:00 pm.
 - Children whose mothers consumed the water at the Pease Tradeport before May 2014 while they were pregnant and/or breastfeeding are also eligible for testing.
- Anyone interested in having their blood tested for PFCs should contact the DHHS Public Inquiry Line by October 2nd to allow for time to process the necessary paperwork.
- Participants who request testing have until October 16th to get their blood drawn.
- Since testing resumed, a total of 835 persons have indicated interest in blood testing for PFCs; this includes 604 adults and 231 children.
- Questionnaires and consent forms are being mailed. DHHS has received back 132 questionnaires and consent forms as of Monday 9/14/15.
