**CONDITIONALLY ENROLLED is defined as having documentation of at least one dose of each required vaccine and an appointment date for the next due dose(s) of the required vaccine(s). Conditionally enrolled students are not considered up-to-date.

***RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION: A parent or legal guardian can object to immunization(s) because of religious beliefs. The parent or legal guardian shall sign a notarized form stating that the child has not been immunized because of religious beliefs.

****MEDICAL EXEMPTION: A physician certifies that immunization against a particular disease may be detrimental to the child's health. The exemption shall exist only for the length of time, in the opinion of the physician, such immunization would be detrimental to the child. An exemption from immunization for one disease shall not affect other required immunizations.

NOTE: All data in this report are based upon information provided to the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services under specific legislative authority. The data for this report was collected electronically. Deadline for submission of the data for this report was November 15, 2017, and is a point-in-time reporting of data.
