

Healthy Communities Demonstration Sites

- NACCHO, with support from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), plans to award up to \$30,000 each to 10 local health departments (LHDs) to:
 - **1) build or strengthen a coalition of community partners and**
 - **2) develop a community action plan to address chronic disease risk factors such as physical inactivity, poor nutrition, and tobacco use at the policy, systems, and environmental change levels**

Eligibility

To be eligible for the demonstration site project, the applicant must:

- Be an active **dues-paying NACCHO member**—an LHD representing local city, county, district, or tribal communities.
- Not currently receiving funding from CDC community-based chronic disease programs (e.g. REACH, Steps, Pioneering Healthy Communities, ACHIEVE)
- Demonstrate the LHD's commitment to the proposed effort, including how the project will collaborate with community partners from various local sources.
- Be willing to share resources and lessons learned with CDC, NACCHO, as well as other LHDs across the country.
- Agree to fulfill all expectations for participation.

Dues are based on population

- 0–24,999 \$55
- 25,000–49,999 \$155
- 50,000–74,999 \$230
- 75,000–99,999 \$375
- 100,000–149,999 \$560
- 150,000–199,999 \$650
- 200,000–299,999 \$755

- Applicants will be asked to submit an application, a proposal addressing the criteria for selection, a proposed budget request, and three letters of support from community partners.
