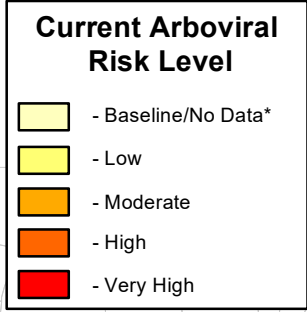


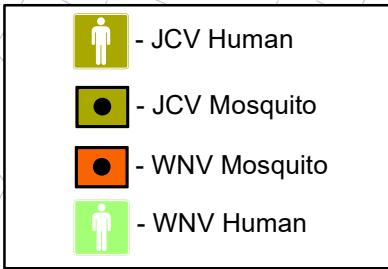

## Arboviral Risk New Hampshire, March 17, 2022

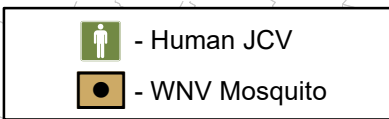

### 2021 Positive Cases



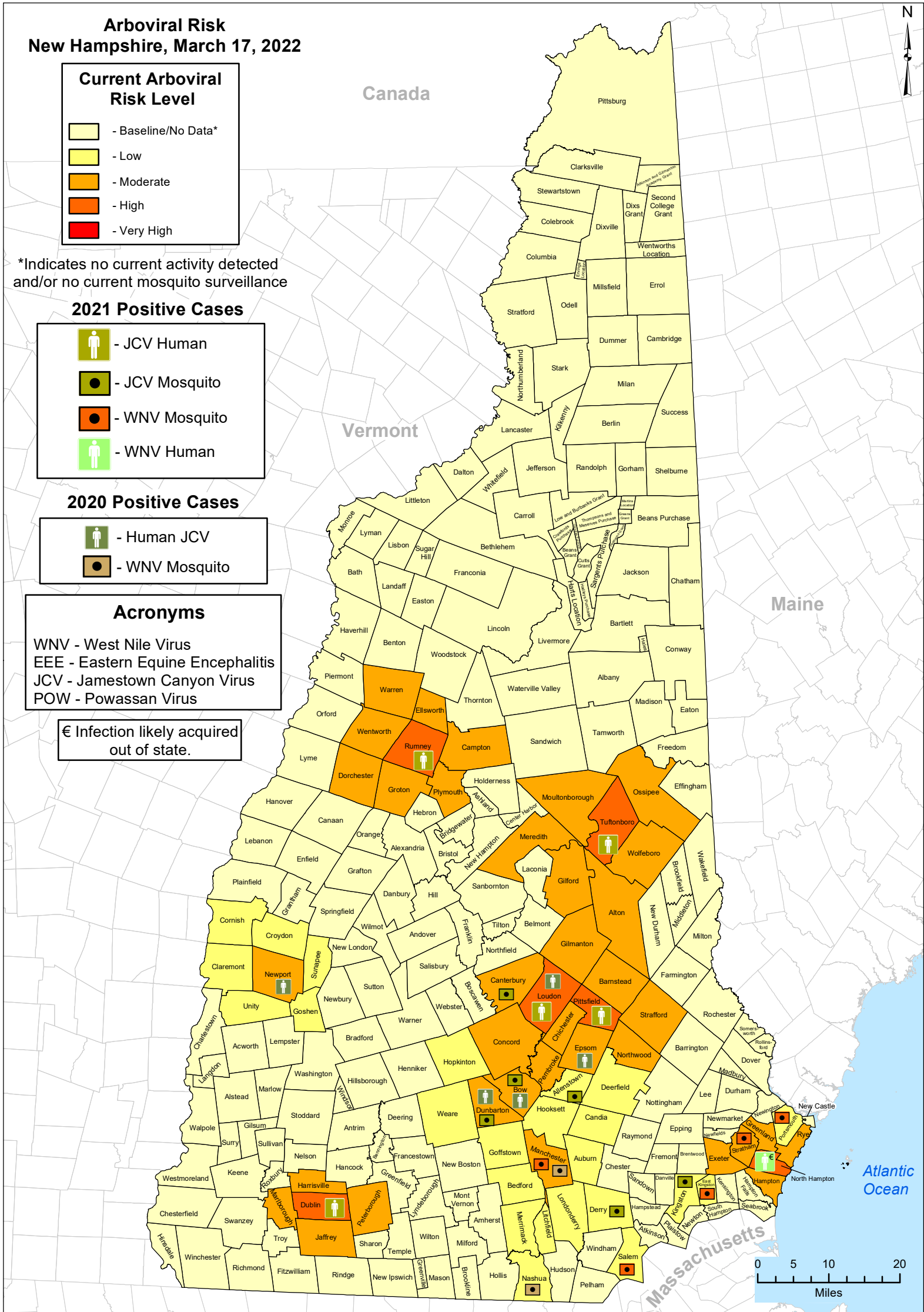
### 2020 Positive Cases
