WHAT IS TITLE IV-A EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE?







The Title IV-A Emergency Assistance program is a federally funded program for eligible DCYF families. The Title IV-A Emergency Assistance program enables DCYF to purchase services to preserve the family or to facilitate reunification and receive federal reimbursement for the cost of the services. The federal reimbursement under the Title IV-A Emergency Assistance program allows the State of New Hampshire to provide services to families at a reduced cost to New Hampshire taxpayers.

The Goal of the Title IV-A Emergency Assistance Program is to preserve the family or reunite the family as soon as possible if a child is temporarily removed from the home.

Receiving services funded under the Title IV-A Emergency Assistance Program will not reduce the amount of reimbursement a family may be required to pay.

Denial of Title IV-A Emergency Assistance **does not** impact other benefits you may be receiving.
