Instructions for Completing the "Lead Abatement Contractor Application":

Who Needs to Complete / Submit this Application?

INITIAL or **RENEWAL APPLICATION** for **LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTING BUSINESSES** of the following types:

- ➤ PERFORMANCE CONTRACTOR (\$300.00): CONDUCT LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION by means of abatement methods utilizing:
 - Lead Abatement Supervisors
 - Lead Abatement Workers
- CONSULTANT CONTRACTOR (\$300.00): CONDUCT ABATEMENT PREPARATION, including INSPECTIONS and DOCUMENTATION and POST-CLEARANCE TESTING activities utilizing:
 - Licensed Lead Inspectors
 - Licensed Risk Assessors

<u>LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION</u> DOES NOT PERMIT THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER TO PHYSICALLY ENGAGE IN LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION OR ABATEMENT PREPERATION ACTIVITIES

<u>LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION</u> DOES NOT PROVIDE THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER ANY PERMISSIONS TO PHYSICALLY ENGAGE IN <u>LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION OR ABATEMENT PREPERATION ACTIVITIES</u>

When Do You Need to Complete / Submit this Application?

- 1) INITIAL APPLICATION CERTIFYING YOUR BUSINESS as a LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR:
 - Once the requirements of He-P 1612.02(g-h) "Licensing or Certification Requirements" have been met.
- 2) RENEWAL of LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION:
 - > ALL CERTIFICATES SHALL EXPIRE 1-YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE.
 - > 60 DAYS BEFORE the expiration date of the current CERTIFICATE.

If you are currently licensed as a **PERFORMANCE** or **CONSULTANT CONTRACTOR** (issued prior to 6/2020) and are a **LEAD ABATEMENT PERFORMANCE** and/or **CONSULTANT CONTRACTOR** business owner. When it is time to renew your license (issued prior to 6/2020) and you would like to continue to physically engage in **LEAD ABATMENT PERFORMANCE** and/or **CONSULTANT CONTRACTOR** activities you will be required to:

- ➤ **COMPLETE / SUBMIT** a <u>"Lead Abatement Contractor Certification"</u> application. Certifying your business.
 - If you were/are licensed as a LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR (issued prior to 6/2020) that number will be reassigned to your business as its new LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION number.
 - COMPLETE / SUBMIT a "Lead Abatement License or <u>Certification"</u> application. Select the "LEAD ABATEMENT SUPERVISOR" discipline, which carries the same permissions as what was the LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR license. Also select the "MULTIPLE DISCIPLINE (HIGHEST DISCIPLINE FEE + \$25.00)".
 - SUBMIT a TOTAL APPLICATION FEE, \$300.00 (Lead Abatement Contractor Certification fee) + \$25.00 (Multiple Discipline Fee) = \$325.00. (>***<)
 - If you were/are licensed as a RISK ASSESSOR or LEAD INSPECTOR
 (issued prior to 6/2020), you will retain your current license number and
 will be assigned a new LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR
 CERTIFICATION number for your business.
 - COMPLETE / SUBMIT a "Lead Abatement License or <u>Certification"</u> application. Select your discipline. Also select the "MULTIPLE DISCIPLINE (HIGHEST DISCIPLINE FEE + \$25.00)".
 - SUBMIT a TOTAL APPLICATION FEE, \$300.00 (Lead Abatement Contractor Certification fee) + \$25.00 (Multiple Discipline Fee) = \$325.00.

What to keep in mind when you are completing the "Lead Abatement Contractor Application" and if you are submitting a "Lead License or Certification Application."

- REVIEW and CONFIRM that you MEET and have SATISFIED ALL of the LICENSING and CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS for the respective DISCIPLINE(S) detailed in He-P 1600 LEAD POISONING PREVENTION AND CONTROL RULES.
 - ➤ INITIAL APPLICATION for a LICENSE / CERTIFICATE: He-P 1612.02 "Licensing or Certification Requirements".
 - RENEWAL APPLICATION of a LICENSE / CERTIFICATE: He-P 1612.07
 "License and Certificate Expirations and Procedures for Renewals".
 - RECIPROCITY: He-P 1612.03 "Reciprocity".
- **2**ND REVIEW and CONFIRM that your application is COMPLETE and that you have included all of the REQUIRED / REQUESTED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS.

He-P 1606.02 Denial, Suspension or Revocation of a License or Certificate:

- (a) The department shall deny a license or certificate of an applicant, a certificate holder, or licensee if he or she:
- (2) Fails to submit a completed application that meets the requirements of He-P 1600 within 30 days after being notified of and given an opportunity to supply missing information.
- <u>3rd</u> **CONFIRM** that you have included the **CORRECT APPLICATION FEE** for the **DESIRED DISCIPLINE(S).**
 - ➤ Also SUBMITTING a "Lead License or Certification Application" with your "Lead Abatement Contractor Application"? ONE of your business "Officers" can take advantage of the discounted "Multiple Discipline (Highest fee + \$25.00) Refer back to: (>***<)</p>
 - ➤ ONE CHECK for ONE APPLICANT DO NOT ISSUE ONE CHECK for MULTIPLE APPLICANTS!
 - > APPLICATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.
- CONFIRM that you have indicated which ADDRESS the LICENSE / CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE MAILED TO.
