Instructions for Completing the "Lead License or Certification Application":

Who Needs to Complete / Submit this Application?

INITIAL or RENEWAL APPLICATION for **ONE or MORE** of the following disciplines:

- ➤ Lead Risk Assessor (\$250.00)
- > Lead Inspector (\$100.00)
- > Lead Abatement Supervisor (\$125.00)
- Owner-Contractor (3 Units or < = \$0) (4-6 Units = \$150.00) (7 Units or > = \$300.00)
- Lead Abatement Worker (\$75.00)
- ➤ Multiple Discipline (Highest Discipline Fee + \$25.00)
- Reciprocity (Fee of Discipline)

When Do You Need to COMPLETE / SUBMIT this Application?

- 1) INITIAL APPLICATION for a LICENSE / CERTIFICATE:
 - Once the requirements of <u>He-P 1612.02 "Licensing or Certification</u> <u>Requirements"</u> have been met for the **DESIRED DISCIPLINE(S)**.
- 2) RENEWAL of a LICENSE / CERTIFICATE:
 - 60 DAYS BEFORE the expiration date of the current LICENSE / CERTIFICATE.
 - Once the requirements of <u>He-P 1612.07 "License and Certificate</u> <u>Expirations and Procedures for Renewals"</u> have been met for the respective LICENSE or CERTIFICATE.

SUBMITTING your application 6 MONTHS BEYOND your LICENSE EXPIRATION DATE? You will be required to RETAKE and SUBMIT a "Certificate of Completion" from an INITIAL LEAD PROFESSIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM a "Certificate of Completion" from a REFRESHER LEAD PROFESSIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM will NOT SUFFICE.

He-P 1612.07 License and Certificate Expirations and Procedures for Renewals.

(h) If an individual's New Hampshire license or certificate lapses, the individual may apply for a new license or certificate, in accordance with He-P 1612.05 without successfully completing the initial educational program if the individual's:

- (1) Proficiency examination results are at least 70% and less than 3 years old for the examination described in He-P 1612.04(a)(2);
- (2) Annual ongoing education requirements listed in He-P 1612.02 are current; and
- (3) The renewal application is received by the department within 6 months after the expiration of the current license or certificate.
 - 3) RENEWING YOUR LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR LICENSE? (Issued prior to 6/2020)
 - "LEAD ABATEMENT CONTRACTOR" now refers to a lead abatement business.
 - On your renewal application you need to SELECT and PAY THE APPLICATION FEE for the "LEAD ABATEMENT SUPERVISOR" discipline.
 - Your renewed license will have a new "DS-_____" license number and will say "LEAD ABATEMENT SUPERVISOR."
 - 4) RECIPROCITY:
- Once the requirements of <u>He-P 1612.03 "Reciprocity"</u> have been met for the **DESIRED DISCIPLINE**.

What to keep in mind when you are completing the "Lead License or Certification Application."

- REVIEW and CONFIRM that you MEET and have SATISFIED ALL of the LICENSING and CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS for the respective DISCIPLINE(S) detailed in He-P 1600 LEAD POISONING PREVENTION AND CONTROL RULES.
 - ➤ INITIAL APPLICATION for a LICENSE / CERTIFICATE: He-P 1612.02

 "Licensing or Certification Requirements".
 - RENEWAL APPLICATION of a LICENSE / CERTIFICATE: <u>He-P 1612.07</u> "License and Certificate Expirations and Procedures for Renewals".
 - RECIPROCITY: He-P 1612.03 "Reciprocity".
- **2**ND REVIEW and CONFIRM that your application is COMPLETE and that you have included all of the REQUIRED / REQUESTED SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS.

He-P 1606.02 Denial, Suspension or Revocation of a License or Certificate:

- (a) The department shall deny a license or certificate of an applicant, a certificate holder, or licensee if he or she:
- (2) Fails to submit a completed application that meets the requirements of He-P 1600 within 30 days after being notified of and given an opportunity to supply missing information.
- **3**rd **CONFIRM** that you have included the **CORRECT APPLICATION FEE** for the **DESIRED DISCIPLINE(S).**
 - ➤ ONE CHECK for ONE APPLICANT DO NOT ISSUE ONE CHECK for MULTIPLE APPLICANTS!
 - APPLICATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.
- $\underline{4^{\text{TH}}}$ CONFIRM that you have indicated which ADDRESS the LICENSE / CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE MAILED TO.
