

What information is reported to the NHIIS?

The information required to be reported to the NHIIS includes:

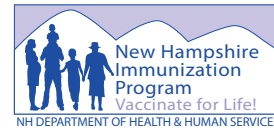
- Patient name
- Date of birth
- Gender, race, ethnicity
- Complete address including county of residence
- Parent/guardian information
- Vaccine information (name, manufacturer, lot number, and date the vaccine was given)

If a patient has a medical or religious vaccination exemption and their information is shared with the NHIIS, their record will be noted with the appropriate exemption.



How do individuals obtain copies of their NHIIS Immunization record?

- Individuals can get their NHIIS immunization record by accessing the NHIIS individual portal using their cell phone or email address at: <https://www.vaccines.nh.gov/vaccination-record-instructions> or requesting a record from NHIIS participating health care providers.

What is the New Hampshire Immunization Information System (NHIIS)?

The NHIIS is a confidential and secure web-based system that stores vaccination records for people of all ages. It is a free tool that helps healthcare providers, pharmacists, and schools make sure that NH residents are vaccinated on time and receive all required and recommended vaccines. All 49 other states in the U.S. have operating immunization information systems.

The NHIIS is a service of the NH Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), Division of Public Health Services (DPHS).

Who has access to the information reported to the NHIIS?

The NHIIS was designed with security, confidentiality, and privacy in mind. The information in the NHIIS is treated like all other private medical information. You and your child's information is only shared with you and your healthcare providers. School nurses will have "view only" access to immunization records, but only for students that they serve.

What are the benefits of the NHIIS?



Helps your healthcare provider make sure you and your child receive all required and recommended vaccinations



Prevents you and your child from receiving too many or too few vaccinations



Sends you a reminder when you or your child are due for a vaccine



Provides proof of vaccination for daycare, school, summer camp, college, travel, employment, military service, and more



Keeps your whole vaccination record in one place - even if you move, change providers, or change health plans



Helps to prevent disease outbreaks in your community



Saves time and keeps records organized for both you and your healthcare provider

Is participation in the NHIIS mandatory?

Participation in the NHIIS is voluntary. You can choose to start or stop sharing you/your child's vaccination information with the NHIIS at any time.

If you do not wish to participate in the NHIIS:

- Contact your healthcare provider(s) to get a "Choose Not to Participate in the New Hampshire Immunization/Vaccination Registry" form.
- If you have multiple healthcare providers who participate in the NHIIS, you must notify and complete a form for each of them.
- It is the responsibility of your healthcare provider(s) to ensure that your information is removed from the NHIIS.
