



## Information about 2022 Form 1095-B

**Posted January 30, 2023 –**

Beginning in early February 2023, all Medicaid beneficiaries who had at least one day of Medicaid coverage in 2022 may request a copy of their Form 1095-B from the Department of Health and Human Services.

Due to the individual shared responsibility penalty remaining at zero for 2022, the IRS has expanded relief for enrollment information since individuals will not need this information to file their federal tax returns. The IRS will not assess a penalty against the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) for failing to furnish Form 1095-B to individuals if two conditions are met:

1. The Department posts a notice prominently on its website stating that Medicaid beneficiaries may receive a copy of their 2022 Form 1095-B upon request, accompanied by an email address and a physical address to which a request may be sent, as well as a telephone number that responsible individuals can use to contact the reporting entity with any questions; and
2. The Department furnishes a 2022 Form 1095-B to any responsible individual upon request within 30 days of the date the request is received.
