In accordance with RSA 126-A:84.IV., I am pleased to submit this annual report regarding the City of Keene Opioid Litigation Settlement distributions totaling \$20,987.51 as of June 30, 2022.

June 2021 = \$7,375.59
June 2022 = \$13,611.92

These funds have been deposited into an Opioid Litigation Settlement Revolving Fund established by the Keene City Council on July 1, 2021. As of this date no funds have been expended.

In the near future the City of Keene will be reviewing community needs and developing a fair and transparent process for how best to spend the funds. We are awaiting information regarding availability of other funds coming into the state so that we may understand in totality how these funds may be put best to use.
