RE: Opioid Litigation Settlement Fund Distribution 2024 Report

Dear Kristy:

Since the last reporting, the County of Cheshire has received three additional distributions from the Opioid Abatement Trust fund in the amount of \$30,321.65 on August 29, 2023 and \$176,059.97 on June 4, 2024.

The combined amount Cheshire County has received to date is \$474,080.92. In 2023, the County allocated \$100,000 of the funds with actual expenses actually incurred of \$76,000. These allotments of funds were directed to 2 outside agencies and 3 departments within the County.

In 2024, the County has again allocated funds totaling \$181,000. Below is the overview of programs that will receive funding:

1. Reality Check, Jaffrey NH - \$10,000 Drug, Alcohol and Addiction Counseling. Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Program.
2. Keene Serenity Center, Keene NH - \$10,000 Drug, Alcohol and Addiction Counseling, Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Program.
3. Monadnock Family Services - \$20,000 Funding for uninsured clients needing medications for opioid additional as well as LADAC License fees and professional development support.
4. Kids Collaborative - \$10,000 Funding to expand prevention and family strengthening services for children and families impacted by opioid use disorder.
5. NH Care Collaborative - \$10,000 Funding to expand prevention and family strengthening services for children and families impacted by opioid use disorder.
6. Y.A.N.A. (You Are Not Alone) - \$20,000 Drug, Alcohol and Addiction Support. Prevention and Recovery Programing.
7. Cheshire County Department of Correction, Keene NH - \$30,000 funding for costs associated with MAT for inmates.
8. Cheshire County Drug Court, Keene NH - \$20,000 funding for Incentive program, client transportation and housing security deposit.
9. Cheshire County Sheriff Department, Keene NH – \$31,000 funding for community law enforcement training, “Trauma of Being a Cop/First Responder”, “Opioid Education for LE/FR”.
10. Cheshire EMS - \$20,000 Regional training on opioid and substance abuse matters.

The funds continue to be placed in a special revenue fund separate from the County’s General Funds.
