When will I have a SIS-A?

Assessments will be prioritized initially for individuals seeking services through the DD waiver who are new to waiver services.

- BDS staff will provide PCG with a prioritized list of individuals.
- PCG staff will schedule SIS-A assessments in collaboration with Area Agencies, service coordination entities, and individuals/families.





Who will administer the SIS-A?

The Bureau of Developmental Services (BDS) has contracted with Public Consulting Group (PCG) to administer the SIS-A assessment in New Hampshire.

 PCG provides assessment work across various Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) communities, with a specific focus on the Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (IDD) community.
