

MEMORANDUM SUMMARY
<p>The purpose of this memorandum is to announce the continuation of the Grab-n-Go Home Delivered Meals service through Title III post Public Health Emergency (PHE) and to provide updated guidance for documentation and reporting requirements for this service.</p>

The Bureau of Elderly and Adult Services (BEAS) is sharing the following information for agencies to consider as they submit service authorizations for Grab-n-Go meals post PHE.

BEAS approved the initiation of Grab-n-Go meals as a method of home delivered service under the Title III flexibilities allowed by the Administration for Community Living (ACL) during the PHE. BEAS updated Administrative Rule He-E 502 to allow for the continuation of this service post PHE.

The PHE ended 05/11/2023. This continuation of Grab-n-Go meals authorized under the He-E 502 is retroactively effective 05/12/2023. Form 3502 Contract Service Authorization or an Options Service Authorization are required to receive funding for this service as of this date.

Providers that do not have an Options service authorization or have not submitted form 3502 for the Grab-n-Go service from 05/12/2023 on, must submit/enter these authorizations retroactively.

Providers should continue to use service code 399 for the service authorizations for Grab-n-Go meals.
