Definitions:

- (1) <u>MEDICAL EXEMPTION</u> (ME): A physician must certify that immunization against a particular disease may be detrimental to the child's health. The exemption shall exist only for the length of time, in the opinion of the physician, such immunization would be detrimental to the child. An exemption from immunization for one disease shall not affect other required immunizations.
- (2) <u>RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION</u> (RE): A parent or legal guardian can object to immunization(s) because of their religious beliefs. They must provide a signed form stating that the child has not been immunized because of religious beliefs.
- (3) <u>CONDITIONALLY ENROLLED</u> (CE): Students have documentation of at least one dose of each required vaccine and an appointment date for the next due dose(s) of the required vaccine(s).
- (4) NOT UP-TO-DATE (NUTD): Students do not have all required immunizations or documentation of all required vaccines AND do not meet conditional enrollment or exemption criteria.
