# STRATEGIC VISION & OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCIES (SVOE) YEAR 2 Q1 INITIATIVE UPDATES

October 2022

## Executive Summary (1 of 2)

- **1. SVOE:** Through Quarter 1, Year 2 of the SVOE contract, all four workstreams remain on-track with each initiative entering various phases of implementation.
- 2. Shorter-term Initiative Progress: (1) Critical Time Intervention (CTI) remains focused on refining operations and driving client adoption of the program and has increased focus on data collection and analysis. (2) The authority issued under the approved IMD Waiver amendment has now been in effect since July 1<sup>st</sup> and has enabled the team to shift focus to reporting automation and other implementation-related priorities; the team has also successfully submitted the demonstration extension to CMS, receiving notice of completeness on September 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. Longer-term Initiative Progress: (3) The Developmental Disabilities (DD) Waiver Redesign initiative continues to focus on stakeholder engagement while shifting into execution of key milestones this fiscal year; rate development, billing system changes, and participant assessment testing are examples of the various efforts underway and scheduled for completion by the end of Year 2. (4) The MES Modernization initiative is working towards the System Integrator procurement and will continue advanced planning and requirements development for additional modules.



## **Highlights**

- CTI launched statewide with 9 of 10 CMHCs staffed with CTI teams, building on the January pilot launch with 4 CMHCs.
- 150+ active clients as of the end of September 2022 (Q1), with referrals coming in from all state DRFs and NHH.
- 3. Year 2 milestones (see timeline) focused on preparing the re-contracting process with CMHCs for FY24-25.

Capacity	Work with CMHCs to address workforce issues to support the steady increase of CTI referrals.	
Operations	Continue data collection and analysis critical to the downstream goal of measuring outcomes.	
Contracts	Conduct the financial, rate, and scope reviews; usher contracts through internal steps for G&C approval in Q4.	


## **Performance Snapshot (Active Clients by Month)**

#### **Status Overview**

#### **Demonstration Extension:**

- 1. The demonstration extension application was submitted to CMS on 9/30/22, accomplishing the State's target milestone for submission.
- 2. CMS issued a notice of completeness on 10/14/22 and began the subsequent 30-day federal public comment period on 10/17/22; CMS may ask the State to respond to specific points of feedback received during this period.
- 3. Once federal public comment period and any subsequent responses are complete, the State will negotiate the approval Special Terms and Conditions (STCs) with CMS.

#### Implementation:


- 1. The New Hampshire Hospital Admission, Discharge, and Transfer Feed (ADT) has been updated; work to troubleshoot and complete field updates to the MMIS must still be completed for the data feed to be automated.
- The team drafted policies and procedures outlining a Utilization Review process for Fee For Service beneficiaries receiving inpatient psychiatric services; review of this documentation will continue through Q2.
- The team is also working to draft process documentation outlining how the Division of Behavioral Health (DBH) and Medicaid will determine which facilities should be characterized and monitored as IMDs; drafting and review will continue through Q2.

# Initiative Update – Overview (DD Systems Redesign – 1 of 2)

Status Over	view
Stakeholder Engagement	The Bureau of Developmental Services (BDS) met with Area Agency directors on 10/5/22, sharing information related to Designated Area Agency Delivery Services (DAADS) billing, data needs, and provider enrollment.  BDS hosted 2 family forums in Laconia (10/10/22) and Manchester (10/11) to hear from families and answer questions about BDS systems work.  BDS and some A&M staff visited two Area Agencies to learn more about service delivery in their regions.
Quality and Capacity	BDS hosted 2 webinars (9/21/22 and 10/6/22) to educate providers about enrolling as Medicaid providers in support of the direct billing requirement.
Waiver Structure	BDS is working to consolidate feedback from the Waiver Work Group into a revised set of service definitions; will reconvene in November.



- 2. Upcoming Focus: Start the SI RFP process.






