Definitions:

- (1) <u>UP-TO-DATE</u> (UTD): Students have all the NH school required vaccines for their age and/or grade.
- (2) <u>CONDITIONALLY ENROLLED</u> (CE): Students have documentation of at least one dose of each required vaccine and an appointment date for the next due dose(s) of the required vaccine(s).
- (3) <u>RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION</u> (RE): A parent or legal guardian can object to immunization(s) because of their religious beliefs. They must provide a signed form stating that the child has not been immunized because of religious beliefs.
- (4) <u>MEDICAL EXEMPTION</u> (ME): A licensed health care provider must certify on letterhead, that immunization against a particular disease may be detrimental to the child's health. The exemption shall exist only for the length of time, in the opinion of a licensed health care provider; such immunization would be detrimental to the child. An exemption from immunization for one disease shall not affect other required immunizations.
- (5) <u>NOT UP-TO-DATE</u> (NUTD): Students do not have all required immunizations or documentation of all required vaccines AND do not meet conditional enrollment or exemption criteria.
