If you are receiving a vaccine at this pharmacy or clinic, your vaccination information may be sent to the New Hampshire Immunization Information System

#### What is NHIIS?

The New Hampshire Immunization Information System (NHIIS) is a HIPAA compliant, web-based system created by the NH Division of Public Health Services (DPHS). NHIIS is a free, secure, and easy way to keep vaccine records up-to-date regardless of where vaccines are administered. New Hampshire is the 50th state in the nation to adopt a vaccine registry.

### How does this affect me?

- Your information will be automatically sent to the NHIIS from your provider office, pharmacy, or clinic if you Opt-In.
- Your vaccine record will be securely stored for you and your provider to view as needed.
- You can download a copy of your or your child's vaccination records for school, childcare, or summer camps.

## What information is reported to NHIIS?

- Basic information such as name, address, phone number, and email.
- Demographic information such as gender, race, and ethnicity.
- Vaccine information such as type of vaccine, lot number, expiration date, and date given.

## How to Opt-In/ Opt-Out:

- You have the right to opt in or out of sharing your information with NHIIS by notifying the administering provider. You may be asked to complete a form indicating your choice.
- If you choose to opt-in, you will be asked to provide explicit consent to share your/your child's information and your/your child's vaccination information will be entered in the NHIIS.
- If you choose to opt-out, your information will not be entered in the NHIIS.
