An analysis of the impact(s), successes and challenges of the project(s), program(s), and/or service(s) funded.

- The funding allowed Seamus, our CRSW to work with four individuals. The following list covers the services provided by this funding:

Individual #1: Provided assistance with housing by providing lists of apartments; attended self-help meetings on at least two occasions and provided transportation to meet UA testing requirements. Provided funding and transportation to obtain medications. Frequent conversations regarding recovery capital. Barrier regarding individual #1 was his inability to obtain housing based on his record even though he filled out several applications for apartments.

Individual #2 Worked on financial literacy; discussed and assisted with navigating the workings of treatment court; assisted with obtaining information to get a driver's license contacting multiple states to move this forward. Brainstormed pro-social activities. Provided a letter of support to assist with obtaining housing. Provided techniques regarding time management and studying habits for courses. Discussed and reflected on current health issues. Connected individual with program leader of restorative Justice program at Cheshire County.

Individual #3 Ongoing conversations regarding recovery capital and following a solid pathway of recovery. Assisted with dental plan regarding dentures, extractions and funding for these. Discussed financial literacy and ways to enhance/increase credit score. Reviewed and discussed setting boundaries and place of employment.

Individual #4 Referred to the YMCA to get a free membership through a collaboration with Cheshire County Treatment Court. Coaching on healthy perspectives towards setting goals and being more optimistic about the future. Provided transportation to continuing education classes. Provided transportation to obtain medications and discussed taking them appropriately. Provided individual with a list of felon friendly employers.
