

Motion to authorize remote meeting participation:

In accordance with RSA 91-A:2, IV, motion to issue a standing authorization that members of the Commission may participate remotely in the following circumstances when their physical attendance is not reasonably practicable:

- Hazardous weather conditions making it unsafe for the Commissioner to drive to the physical meeting location;
- Medical condition of the Commissioner or of a member of the Commissioner's immediate family or household that require the Commissioner attend remotely;
- The Commissioner has childcare responsibilities making it impractical to attend;
- Lack of transportation to the physical meeting location;
- The Commissioner is traveling out of state; or,
- The Commissioner's drive within state to the meeting location would be excessive.
- The Commissioner's job responsibilities make it practically impossible for him/her to attend in person.

Commissioners who demonstrate that one of these circumstances apply may be counted toward a quorum and may fully participate, provided, however, that at least one-third of other Commissioners are physically present at the meeting location, and provided that those Commissioners participating remotely can see, hear and be seen by everyone in attendance. The Commissioner participating remotely must identify all other persons present at his/her remote location. The minutes of the meeting must state the authorized reason a commissioner participated remotely. All votes on matters, when at least one commissioner participates remotely, must be by rollcall.
