On December 13, 2021, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, soliciting proposals for the provision of a Facilitating Organization (FO) to develop and support infrastructure and provide program support to Recovery Community Organizations (RCOs) and Recovery Centers across the State. The FO will ensure financial, operational, and technical assistance and training to support the existing RCOs.

- 2. Modify Section 3, Statement of Work, Subsection 3.1., Scope of Services, Paragraph 3.1.17., State Opioid Response (SOR) Grant Standards, by adding Subparagraph 3.1.17.3. as follows:
 - 3.1.17.3. The selected Vendor must coordinate completion of Government Performance Results Act (GPRA) initial interview and associated follow-up interviews at six (6) months and discharge for individuals referenced in section <u>3.1.17.2.</u> with Regional Doorways.

3. Modify Section 4, Finance, Subsection 4.1. Financial Standards, by adding Subparagraph 4.1.3. as follows:

4.1.3. The total anticipated award amount of \$6,750,000 is broken out across fiscal years as follows:

SFY 2022 Contract effective date through 6/30/2022	SFY 2023 7/1/2022 through 6/30/2023	SFY 2024 7/1/2023 through 6/30/2024
<u>\$835,000</u>	<u>\$3,115,000</u>	\$2,800,000
