

ADDENDUM #2

RFP-2022-DPHS-16-OPIOI Opioid Education for Healthcare Organizations (Changes are in <u>bold, underlined and italicized text</u> below to enable vendors to quickly recognize changes in paragraphs and/or wording.)

On March 2, 2022, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, to solicit proposals from qualified vendors to provide evidence-based opioid prescribing education, training, and technical assistance to healthcare organizations regarding opioid prescribing guidelines and non-opioid or non-pharmaceutical treatment for pain management.

The Department is publishing this addendum to:

- 1. Delete and replace Section 3, Statement of Work, Subsection 3.2., Scope of Services, Paragraph 3.2.13, with the following:
 - 3.2.13 The selected Vendor must engage a minimum of <u>approximately</u> 300 individuals in a minimum of <u>approximately</u> 100 practice settings who assist individuals who use prescription drugs with a focus on service providers who engage a higher proportion of people with SUD including, but not limited to:
 - 3.2.13.1. Community health centers.
 - 3.2.13.2. Recovery community organizations.
 - 3.2.13.3. Emergency departments.
