Helping NH Residents Find a Path to Long Term Services and Supports

There are many paths available in New Hampshire to help people of all ages live better in their communities. NHCarePath was created to help people find and follow the right path for them. Its name, and easily identifiable logo, will appear on information describing LTSS, and as part of a statewide outreach and education campaign to help ensure that those in need of support are aware of all their options for home and community LTSS.

The Balancing Incentive Program (BIP) is a part of a larger system change effort within the NH Department of Health and Human Services (NH DHHS). The BIP award provides grant funds to rebalance Medicaid spending between institutional and community long term supports and services (LTSS). The goal of BIP is to provide persons with greater access to home and communitybased services and to reduce reliance on institutional services.

The three priorities for BIP are:

- Standardize and streamline the systems and processes that are used to determine eligibility and assess needs for LTSS
- Improve access to community LTSS
- **Rebalance Medicaid spending within New Hampshire's** system of LTSS.
